- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late;
- Members must wear suitable kit – (*whites for matches, track suit and white tops for training*);
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly;
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club;
- All facilities must be used under supervision or child coaches or appointed person.
